

HUMAN ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY 1, 2

Course Length: 2 Semesters

Credit per Semester: 1.0 (Science or Elective)

Grade: 10, 11, 12

Prerequisite: Satisfactory completion of PES Science 1, 2 and Biology 1, 2 or department approval.

Lab Fee: \$5.00 plus materials fee

This course is a systematic study of the structure and functions of the human body. The curriculum covers the major organ systems of the human body as they relate to health and disease. Instruction uses laboratory activities including mandatory cat dissections to enable students to visualize basic anatomical structures comparable to those in humans. This course serves as initial preparation for study in physical education, health, and medical sciences.
